## Teacher Summative Evaluation

Three measures of teaching proficiency are used to determine a teacher's summative score and performance rating: teacher observations, a teacher portfolio (including PGP), and instructional time as indicated by teacher attendance and punctuality. The observations represent $60 \%$ of the Summative Score, the portfolio represents $30 \%$, and instructional time represents $10 \%$. The Summative Score is then translated into a Performance Rating of Distinguished, Proficient, Basic, or Unsatisfactory.

## Final Performance Rating

(TalentEd assigns the Final Performance Rating (Distinguished, Proficient, Basic, or Unsatisfactory) based on the Summative Score.)
